

EXAMINATION RULES & REGULATIONS

Official Guidelines for the Academic Session 2026–2027

Timeline Mandate: All annual examinations for the 2026–2027 academic session will be completed by the month of **March 2027**.

1. Assessment Structure by Grade Track

- **Nursery, KG I, and KG II (Pre-Primary):** Progress is monitored via **continuous assessments** conducted throughout the year. Official Grade Cards detailing these assessments are declared and distributed periodically.
- **Class I to VIII (Primary & Middle School):** Mandatory **Unit Tests** covering all core subjects are systematically conducted throughout the academic year. In addition to Unit Tests, students must sit for formal **Half-Yearly and Annual Examinations**. Teachers will also conduct unannounced surprise class tests, practical projects, and periodic internal assessments. The entire syllabus framework is distributed during the active session across both the Junior and Senior sections.

2. Attendance & Absence Policy

- **Strict Re-examination Bar:** Any pupil who misses a scheduled examination or block test **will not be permitted under any circumstances** to appear for the same assessment at a later date.
- **Promotion Evaluations:** If a student's absence from an exam is officially justified and backed by proper documentation, the academic committee will formally take the matter into account at the time of final year-end promotion decisions.
- **Health Advisory:** Parents are strongly requested and advised **not to send children to school for examinations** if they are actively ill or in the process of recovering from a medical ailment.

3. Board Examination Provisions (CBSE)

- **Study Leave Allowance:** Formal study leave is officially sanctioned and granted to registered CBSE board track students immediately following the conclusion and evaluation of their school **Selection Examinations**.
